The Harvest

The Grenache is sourced from old bush vines in the Piekenierskloof at an altitude of 700 meters above sea level. The vineyard was planted in the 1970's and grows in decomposed sandstone soils.

Cellar Notes & Blending Information

Grape Varietals: Grenache

Style of Wine: Fruit focused and terroir driven

Vinification: The wine is made with 30% whole bunch and undergoes spontaneous fermentation

Maturation: 12 Months in combination of concrete egg shaped vessels and old 500L barrels

Maturation Potential

The Piekenierskloof Grenache should reach its peak between 3-5 years maturation.



Tasting Note

The wine shows bright red fruit with wild herbs and pepper on the nose, balanced with fine tannins and a mineral edge to the finish.
